NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Pursuant to Government Code sections 56381, 56660, and 57000, notice is hereby given that the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of Monterey County will hold public hearings to consider the actions listed below. All persons wishing to make presentations regarding the proposed actions will be heard.

On Monday, March 30, 2015 at 4:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers of the Monterey County Government Center (168 W. Alisal Street, Salinas 93901):

1. Adoption of a 2015 Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence Study for the Pajaro/Sunny Mesa Community Services District, and approval of the District's proposed Sphere of Influence Amendment and Annexation of areas already served by the following District-owned and -operated water systems (LAFCO File No. 14-05)
 - Moss Landing Water Service, Inc. in the Moss Landing area, and
 - NORMCO, Blackie Road #18, Vierra Canyon, and Langley/Valle Pacifico water systems in the Prunedale area.

As the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the District has determined its proposal to be exempt from environmental review pursuant to Sections 15061 (b)(3) and 15320 of the CEQA Guidelines.

If the proposed Sphere of Influence Amendment and Annexation actions are approved at the March 30, 2015 meeting, then LAFCO will hold Conducting Authority ("Protest") Proceedings to order the Sphere of Influence Amendment and Annexation without election, subject to the protest thresholds specified in State law (Government Code sections 57000-57200).

Written protests regarding the approval of the proposed Sphere of Influence Amendment and Annexation may be filed by registered voters residing within the area of the proposal, or by owners of land within the area of the proposal. Written protests concerning the project may be filed with the LAFCO Executive Officer at LAFCO's office address listed above. Written protests must be filed no later than the conclusion of the Conducting Authority Proceedings in order to be considered valid.
